The Ganges basin is the most heavily populated river basin in the world, with over 400 million people and a population density of about 1,000 inhabitants per square mile (390 /km²). The Ganga was ranked among the five most polluted rivers of the world in 2007.

These rivers include Himalayan snow fed rivers, peninsular rainfed rivers and coastal short rapids. The total geographical area of 3.29 million square km of the country has been divided into 12 major river basins, 46 medium river basins and 14 minor and desert river basins.

The total catchment area of the river is 127,950 sq km out of which 45% is in India and the rest lies in Nepal and Tibet. The river has a high flood frequency and has shifted its course several times. Its average annual flow is 94,000 million cubic metre.
